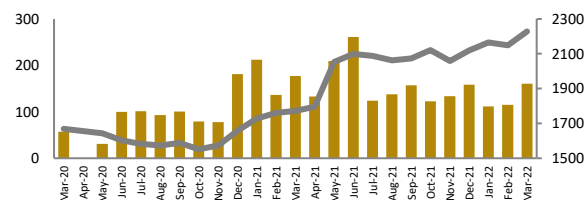

News and Updates

- Profits after tax attributed to shareholders for the public shareholding companies listed on ASE that provided the stock exchange with its financial statements amounted to JD 1,328.4 million in 2021, compared to JD 384.5 million recorded in 2020; showing an increase of 245.5%. Profits before tax amounted to JD 1,849.8 million for the year 2021, compared to JD 667.3 million for the year 2020, which represents an increase of 177.2%. ASE
- Jordan's GDP at constant prices grew by 2.6% in the fourth quarter of 2021 relative to the same quarter of 2020. In 2021, Jordan's GDP grew by 2.2% compared to the prior year. Department of Statistics
- Number of apartments sold in the first quarter of 2022 dropped by 13% to 9,461 apartments, compared to 8,390 apartments sold during the same period of 2021. Department of Land and Survey
- Real estate trading in Jordan increased by 37% in the first quarter of 2022 to amount to JD 1,414 million compared to JD 1,030 million recorded during the same period of 2021. Department of Land and Survey
